





### Advanced Cornea Course: PPV

Pars plana vitrectomy offers various advantages over the anterior chamber approach for vitrectomies. Most textbook descriptions on vitrectomies involve complex posterior segment surgeries. Anterior segment surgeons need to be familiar with the pars plana approach to provide the best outcomes for patients!

This course will help surgeons learn techniques for non-complicated vitrectomies in cases with vitreous prolapse, vitreous opacities, blocked filtration tubes, and removing IOLS dislocated into the vitreous cavity.
